Making Plays with Folklores of the World Residency

Making Plays with Folklores of the World is a hands on class designed to teach students about world cultures while developing their writing skills, teamwork and a love of theater. The class will be customized based on student age and world region desired, from the ancient Mayan or Aztecs to folklore from Eastern Europe. Students will read stories from the region and together with the leadership of professional directors/actors, who incorporate advanced elements of theater and performing arts, will develop a play based on the story. "Making Plays with Folklores of the World" promises to educate about history, geography, writing, and culture while also promoting a healthy lifestyle and improving self-esteem.

Students Will:

- Read out loud, in groups, various stories and myths.
- Build costumes, props, and sets for public performance.
- Work together to create an original play based on stories read.
- Learn about how the geography influenced stories and traditions of cultures around the world.

Session I (7/6-7/10/15): The Coqui and the Iguana

Session III (7/20-7/24/15): How Tiger Got His Stripes
